REEM AL FAISAL

Reem Al Faisal (b. 1968) explores solitude in modern society and within ourselves through her photography. With a degree in Arabic Literature from King Abdul Aziz University, Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, Reem Left the kingdom to pursue a photographic career in Paris, France where she studied Photography in *Spéos* International School of Photography in Paris. She is the first woman photographer to document the entire Hajj, and the first from the Gulf region to have exhibited her work in Palestine.
